

Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 1990 (No. 1)

IT is hereby notified that the Council of Veterinary Surgeons, with the approval of the Minister of Lands, Agriculture and Rural Resettlement, has, in terms of sections 26 and 48 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act [*Chapter 227*], made the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) (Amendment) Regulations, 1990 (No. 1).

2. Section 4 of the Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) Regulations, 1980, published in Statutory Instrument 293 of 1980 (hereinafter called “the principal regulations”), is amended by the repeal of paragraphs (d) and (e) and the substitution of—

“(d) an examination fee of ninety dollars.”.

3. Section 6 of the principal regulations is repealed and the following is substituted—

“6. The Registrar shall pay from the funds of the Council—

(a) an examiner’s fee to each examiner of one hundred dollars per examination;

(b) an invigilator’s fee of five dollars per hour to each invigilator appointed by him to invigilate the examinations.”.
