

Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) (Amendment)
Regulations, 1993 (No. 2)

IT is hereby notified that the Council of Veterinary Surgeons, with the approval of the Minister of Lands, Agriculture and Water Development, has, in terms of sections 26 and 48 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act [*Chapter 227*], made the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993 (No. 2).

2. Section 4 of the Veterinary Surgeons (Local Examinations) Regulations, 1980, published in Statutory Instrument 293 of 1980, (hereinafter called “the principal regulations”) is amended—

(a) in subsection (1) by the deletion of paragraph (d) and the substitution of “an examination fee determined by the Council.”;

(b) in subsection (4) by the repeal of the proviso, and the substitution of the following—

“Provided that the local examinations shall be—

(i) held not less than once a year, unless a period of twelve months has elapsed from the date of the previous local examinations and no application has been received during that period; and

(ii) written and conducted in the English language.”;

(c) by the insertion after subsection (5) of the following subsection—

“(5a) No person shall be permitted, on or after 31st January, 1993, to write the local examination on more than three occasions.”;

(d) by the repeal of subsection (8).

3. Section 6 of the principal regulations is repealed and the following is substituted—

“6. The members of the Board and any person who is appointed by the Registrar to invigilate the examinations shall be paid such fees as are fixed from time to time by the Council.”.
