

Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations,
2002 (No. 1)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Lands, Agriculture and Rural Resettlement has approved the following regulations made by the Council of Veterinary Surgeons of Zimbabwe in terms of section 48 of the Veterinary Surgeons Act [*Chapter 27:15*]:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations, 2002 (No. 1).

2. Section 3 of the Veterinary Surgeons (Registration) Regulations, 2001, published in Statutory Instrument 251 of 2001 (hereinafter called “the principal regulations”) is amended by the deletion of “four hundred and fifty dollars” and the substitution of “seven hundred and ninety dollars”.

3. Section 4 of the principal regulations is amended by the insertion after subsection (2) of the following subsection—

“(3) The fee payable for the issue of a certificate referred to in subsection (2) shall be seven hundred and ninety dollars.”.

4. Section 7 of the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of “two hundred dollars” and the substitution of “three hundred dollars”.

5. Section 8 of the principal regulations is amended—

(a) in subsection (1) by the deletion of “one thousand and two hundred dollars” and the substitution of “two thousand one hundred dollars”;

(b) by the deletion of subsection (2) and the substitution of—

“(2) An annual fee of three hundred and fifty dollars shall be payable by retired members for as long as they remain registered.”;

(c) by the deletion of subsection (3) and the substitution of—

“(3) The annual fee shall become due and payable on the 2nd January of each year.”.

6. Section 9 of the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of “one thousand and two hundred dollars” and the substitution of “two thousand one hundred dollars”.

7. Section 11 of the principal regulations is amended by the deletion of “two hundred dollars” and the substitution of “one hundred dollars”.
